Dr. Yoojin Muhn is the Director of Choral Activities at the University of Texas at San Antonio, where she leads a dynamic choral program, conducts the UTSA Chamber Singers, and teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in choral conducting. She also serves as the Music Director of the San Antonio Mastersingers, a premier 120-voice volunteer chorus representing the greater San Antonio area.

Dr. Muhn is widely recognized for her artistry as a clinician, guest conductor, and adjudicator. She has led numerous honor choirs across Texas and beyond, including serving as a guest conductor for the Louisiana Music Educators Association (LMEA) All-State Choir. Under her direction, the UTSA Chamber Singers have earned invitations to perform at prestigious national and state conferences, including the American Choral Directors Association National Conference and the Texas Music Educators Association Conference.

Dr. Muhn earned her Doctor of Musical Arts in Choral Music with honors from the University of Southern California, a Master of Music in Choral Conducting from the University of Cincinnati-College Conservatory of Music, a Master of Music in Sacred Music (with distinction) from Westminster Choir College, and a Bachelor of Arts in Composition from SookMyung Women's University in Seoul, South Korea.
